

RESTAURANTS

Sóller

C'an Boqueta: Lovely set lunch and dinner. Excellent value. Just 2 minute walk from hotel. Outside terrace in summer.

Casa Alvaro: Tapas, paella and delicious lamb, with some outside tables.

Ca'n Pintxo: Creative tapas and pintxos, outside seating.

Hotel La Vila: Main square of Sóller. Broad, easy-going menu.

Luna 36: Good local bistro on main shopping street. Small courtyard space.

Sa Granja: Family-run restaurant on the main square. No-frills but very good quality.

Fornalutx

Café Med: Just off the main square. Quaint bistro on a lovely cobbled-street.

Ca'n Natuna: Rustic mountain menu (Sucking Pig) with lovely views.

Es Turo: Hearty Mallorcan food, tasty paella, beautiful views.

Port Sóller

Es Passeig: Beach front promenade. Quality restaurant with great sea and port views.

Agapanto: Romantic beach setting. Eclectic restaurant with pretty terrace. Jazz nights and cocktails.

Noname: attractive tapas & dishes to share, "big bowl" salads, Peruvian ceviches, fish, veggie and vegan specialities

El Pirata: Lively harbour setting with terrace. Varied menu & fusion-style tapas.

Esplendido: Inside the Hotel Esplendido (also has a small terrace with sea views). Good bistro and grill for off-season cooler nights.

Randemar: Broad Mediterranean food menu + pizzas. Views of the bay.

Nunu: Overlooking bay (great sunsets). Mediterranean cuisine with creative touch.

Kingfisher: Harbour location. Family-run, (mainly) seafood, fish and meat.

Só Caprichos: Quieter harbour location. Friendly spot for lunch & evening. Views of the boats.

Sa Barca: Modern Mediterranean food in contemporary surroundings. Outdoor terrace with sea views.

Deia (25 min taxi journey)

Bens D'Avall: Top-end cuisine. Amazing coastal and mountain views. Only offer set tasting menus.

Es Raco des Teix: 1-star Michelin. Pretty garden setting. One of Mallorca's top 5 restaurants.

Sebastian: Intimate restaurant in centre of village. Very good cuisine. Celebrity hangout. No outside terrace.

Deia Coast

Ca's Patro March: On the beach at Cala Deià. Wooden "shack" serving classic seafood and fish dishes, perfect for Sunday lunch.

Sa Foradada: Only accessible by foot (1 hour walk from road) or by boat/water taxi. Fish and paella specials. Stunning location and swimming.

IMPORTANT:

Please note that it is often very difficult to order a taxi back from Ca's Patro March or Sa Foradada, especially in high season, so please do make sure you have planned your return journey or you may find yourself stranded!
